

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- The objectives of this course when completed are to enable the delegate:
- To have an overview of ISO14001:2004 and the requirements for internal audit.
- To understand the activities, responsibilities & characteristics of an internal auditor.
- To understand and appreciate the differences between compliance and effectiveness internal audits.
- Plan, conduct and report an internal audit of part of environmental management system in accordance with ISO 19011
- To carry out an internal audit and gather objective evidence through observation, interview & sampling of documents & records.
- To present audit findings and write the audit report.
- To understand the processes for corrective action, preventive action, follow-up and management review.

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE REQUIREMENTS:

It is recommended that students have some understanding of ISO 14001:2004.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- Describe with reference to the Plan, Do, Check, Act (PDCA) cycle and the Model of a Process-based Environmental Management System, the purpose and structure of ISO 14001:2004.
- Plan, conduct and report an internal audit of part of environmental management system in accordance with ISO 19011.


